

Title of abstract in Arial font: size14 point, centered paragraph

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The main text, like the author names used Times New Roman font, 14 point for the Author names and 12 point for the remainder of the abstract. Type or paste your text into this file, but remember to keep the page margins the same as is set here which is 2.5 cm all round. Paragraphs are justified (straight-edged) on both left and right.

Use single-line spacing and leave a line gap between paragraphs. This helps your text to be read easily. No figures are allowed.

Abstracts should be converted to pdf for upload.

The abstract deadline is September 1st. There is no fee for submission of an abstract, but if you do not register by the deadline of September 1st, the abstract will not appear in the program.

If you need to receive a formal acceptance of your abstract in order to be funded to come to the conference, please contact Laura.Saba@cuanschultz.edu and you will receive a prompt reply.

The organizers expect that there may be more abstracts submitted with preference for oral presentation than can be accommodated in the program. They will inform those who submit abstracts for oral presentation whether the paper is scheduled for oral or poster presentation and will aim to do so by September 11th. Please note that there will be ample time for discussion of posters built into the conference schedule.

The limit for your abstract is one page. Abstracts that do not meet these formatting requirements will be returned. Abstracts will NOT be edited by the organizing committee. The submitted abstract will appear as is in the meeting program.
